The Queensland Government is looking for people with expertise in multiculturalism to participate on boards.



Why be on a board?

The Queensland Government strongly believes cultural diversity brings great economic and social benefits to the community.

Being a member of a board or committee is one way you can ensure culturally diverse perspectives are included in Government decision-making. Your involvement will ensure that multiculturalism features when decisions are taken which affect all Queenslanders.

Board and committee members have the opportunity to make a valuable contribution to the community by being involved in Government decision-making. This considerable decision-making responsibility can affect the social and economic wellbeing of Queenslanders.

There are hundreds of boards and committees in Queensland that draw their members from the community or professional groups. For example, some boards and committees provide policy advice to Government or oversee Government trading enterprises, while others are professional registration boards.

How can Queenslanders with expertise in multiculturalism get involved with Government bodies?

Get involved by registering interest in joining a Government board.

The Queensland Government operates the *Queensland Register of Nominees to Government Bodies* – a confidential database of men and women of different ages, interests and backgrounds who are interested in being on a Government board or committee.

The Queensland Government wants to share in the wealth of expertise and skills within the community to ensure that all Queenslanders are represented in the decision-making process.



Who is eligible to join the register?

All Queenslanders are eligible to join the register and be considered for appointment to a range of Government bodies.

Queensland men and women from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds or who have a good understanding of multiculturalism are especially encouraged to apply.

Having a greater representation of these groups will ensure that Queensland uses its diversity for everyone's interests.

Young people under 18 years of age need to have written consent from a parent or guardian to join the register.

How does the register work?

When a Government-nominated position on a board or committee becomes vacant, the relevant Minister requests a list from the register of people with skills and knowledge to suit the position.

If you are selected, the Government agency responsible for the vacancy will contact you directly.

NB: Providing your information to the register database does not guarantee you an appointment to a Government body, but it does increase your chance of being involved.

Who has access to your information on the register?

All information on the register is confidential. Your information is provided to Government departments, agencies and Ministers, on request, for the sole purpose of selecting an applicant to be appointed to a Government board or committee.

If you indicate that you would like to be involved with non-Queensland Government boards and advisory committees then, upon request, your information may be provided to them as well.

If you indicate on your registration form that you would like to receive information from Government agencies on services and events, your contact details may also be provided to these agencies.

NB: From time to time you will be asked to update your details to ensure all information on the database is current.

How do I join the register?

Just follow this easy three-step process:

1. Complete the attached registration form
2. Include a one to two page resumé of your work history and/or skills
3. Send the completed registration form and resumé to:
